



VISIT SPURN LIGHTHOUSE

Climb to the top of this 128ft tall lighthouse, discover its secrets and enjoy unparalleled panoramic views of Yorkshire's very own 'Land's End'.

The newly restored Spurn Lighthouse sits within the wildlife haven of Spurn National Nature Reserve. Visitors to this iconic landmark can make their way along the three and a half mile peninsula walk or cycle routes, or climb aboard a Spurn Safari to travel in style.

Lighthouse Prices

Adults	£4
Senior citizen / Concession	£3
Children	£2
Family Ticket (2 adults and 3 children)	£10

It is free to visit the ground floor of the lighthouse. Refreshments are available for sale. The nearest toilets are located opposite the jetty.

- Open 11am to 3:30pm (last entry 3pm) on Friday, Saturday and Sunday
- Opening hours and days are extended during school holidays – check the website for details
- Children are very welcome but must be able to climb and descend the stairs unaided
- Some high tides see Spurn cut off from the mainland. It is very important to check the tide times carefully. These are displayed at Spurn and are available on the website.

Spurn Safaris

Take a two and half hour tour aboard our all-terrain Unimog in the company of a knowledgeable guide. Tickets cost £12 for adults and £6 for children, which includes a visit to the lighthouse. Spurn Safaris take place throughout the year, view all dates at www.ywt.org.uk/whats-on.
