Located on the edge of one of the natural wonders of Britain and offering a unique coastal environment, the Spurn Discovery Centre is a purpose-built gateway introducing visitors to the spectacular wildlife, evocative landscape and rich natural and social history of Spurn.

Dedicated education space within the Discovery Centre provides the perfect introduction to the 3.5 mile tidal island of Spurn, which stretches out across the mouth of the Humber into the North Sea.

One of Yorkshire's finest remaining wildernesses, Spurn is an intriguing place in terms of the habitats and species waiting to be discovered, spanning beaches, sand dunes and mudflats.
