

Where will your **adventure** take you?

I only have an hour...

Follow the Railway Route look out for ducks and geese and listen out for the explosive song of a Cetti's warbler along the road.

I only have few hours...

Why not follow the Discovery Zone Trail to Beeston Plantation. Look out for signs of roe deer and listen out for woodpeckers on the way.

I have half a day...

You can do all of the above plus fully explore the Dragonfly Trail. Follow the old railway lines down through St Catherine's Copse. Look out onto Willow Marsh and see the birds on the feeders—a great place to see willow tit. Look at the fantastic plants and insects here throughout spring and summer.

I have a full day!...

You can walk all the way around Huxter Well Marsh as well as the three other routes. Head down to Mitchell Hide and listen out for the bitterns booming and watch the majestic marsh harriers patrolling the top of the reeds for their prey! Piper Marsh is also a good place to watch the bird and insect life throughout the year.
