What to expect on our events

SEASHORE SAFARI

On a Seashore Safari you will be guided through the rockpools at South Landing to explore the shore and discover the weird and wonderful wildlife that lives there. Expect to find crabs, snails, fish, worms, anemones and many different seaweeds. Alongside experts from the Living Seas team you will be provided with a spotter sheet to help with identification. Wear wellington boots and dress for the weather. All equipment provided.

SEASHORE DETECTIVE

Take a walk along the strandline - the strip of debris left along the beach at the highest tide - at South Landing and become a Seashore Detective. With the help of experts from the Living Seas team we will be looking for treasures washed up by the sea and what these tell us about our local marine environment. Expect shells, rocks, fossils, mermaid's purses (shark and ray egg cases) and more! Wear sensible footwear and dress for the weather.

WAVES OF WASTE BEACH CLEANS

Help us clean our local beaches with our Waves of Waste Co-ordinators. All equipment will be provided and we will need your help to survey a set section of beach, logging all litter to help us better understand our local marine litter problems. Wear sensible footwear and dress for the weather.

MARINE LIFE PAST AND PRESENT

Join us as we look at the wildlife that lives in our rockpools today, and compare it with local fossils. If you love rockpooling and fossil hunting this is the perfect event for you! Wear wellington boots and dress for the weather. These events involve a walk of 2-3 miles. Family events These events are aimed at a family audience. Children of all ages are welcome but must be accompanied by an adult.

Adult events These events are aimed at an adult audience. Children 15 years and over are welcome to book on. These events may last longer or cover a greater distance than a family event.

What to bring

Events are carried out in all weathers so please check the forecast before visiting and dress accordingly. Wellington boots are best, or stout, waterproof footwear. All equipment is provided.

Home Education Connection 2020 Programme

Join us at the Living Seas Centre to learn more about our local seas and marine wildlife. Marine Protected Areas

Monday 3rd February; 2pm – 4pm Learn what a Marine Protected Area is, why they are important and what MPA's we have in Yorkshire. Participants will get to design their own MPA as well as getting creative on the beach.

Sounds of the Seashore

Monday 2nd March; 2pm – 4pm We will explore the sounds we have on the seashore. Using mini-hydrophones we will see if we can record what is going on in our rockpools and create an underwater soundscape!

Oceanography Monday 6th April; 2pm – 4pm

We will be learning about the science of Oceanography, looking at tides, ocean mapping and technology used to explore the seabed.

Marine Life and Taxonomy

Monday 4th May; 2pm – 4pm We will be looking at the diversity of marine wildlife and how they are grouped together. We will then explore the shore at South Landing to see how many different taxonomic groups we can find!

Plankton

We will be looking at some of our tiniest marine wildlife – the plankton. Using our microscopes we will try to identify phytoplankton and zooplankton. We will then design our own!

Geology and Fossils Monday 6th July; 2pm – 4pm

We will be learning about the history of our local rocks before exploring our extensive collection of fossils. We will then head down to the beach to find our own treasures.

Intertidal Marine Life

Bird Ringing and Migration

Autumn on the Yorkshire Coast

Witness the amazing spectacle that is bird migration! The Yorkshire coast is often first landfall for birds such as fieldfare, redwing and goldcrest as they arrive from Scandinavia to spend the winter here in the UK.

Migweek 2020
