



### You will need:

- 1 paper plate
- Coloured paper
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 glue stick
- 2 eye stickers
- Coloured pens

### Instructions

Take the paper plate and cut out a small section of the edge so your hermit crab has an opening in their shell.

Decorate your paper plate with the coloured pens to be the hermit crab's shell

Now draw around your hand on a piece of coloured paper, this makes the hermit crab's head

Turn your plate over and stick the head to the plate so most of it is sticking out of the 'hole' you made in the paper plate

You can now decorate your crab's head...don't forget their eyes!

Congratulations, you have made a hermit crab
