



You will need:

- 1 card shark
- 1 paper plate
- 1 small paper fish
- Coloured pens,
- 1 pair of scissors,
- 1 glue stick

Instructions

Cut out triangles around the edge of the paper plate to make teeth

Fold the plate in half

Starting from the middle of the plate draw a red tongue

Glue the bottom half of the plate onto the middle of the shark like a mouth

Glue the small paper fish into the shark's mouth

Decorate your shark and don't forget the eyes!
