



Eggs to cut out and hide...

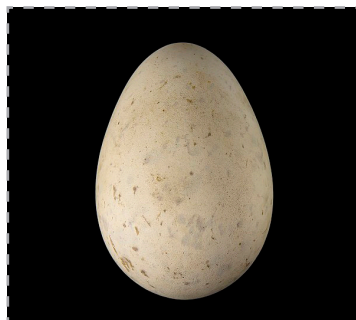
Who laid this egg?



With my lovely textured skin I don't have any fur; there are also no whiskers and I don't go purr!



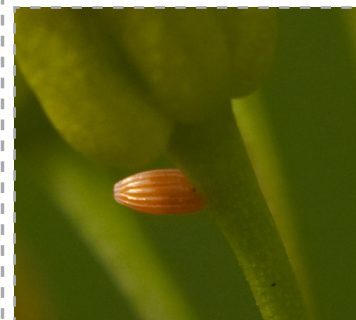
Who laid this egg?
