

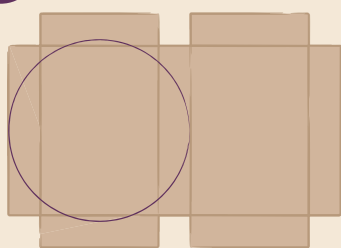
How to make a quick and easy **mushroom hat**

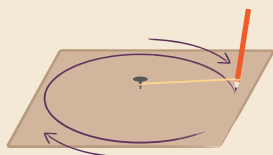


Get a cardboard cereal box and flatten it.

2

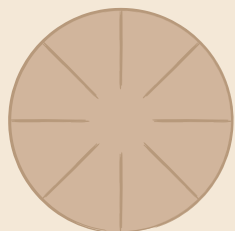


Draw the biggest circle you can.



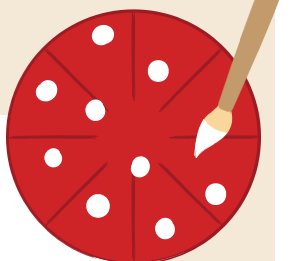
Either freestyle it or use a pin to tack a bit of string to the box, tie a pencil to the other end and draw.

Cut the circle out. Cut lines towards the centre, but not all the way.

Now is the time to decorate the cardboard side. Paint it red with spots, or use pens.

Bend the cardboard a little so it looks like a dome and tape the sections on the inside, or overlap them and use glue.



5

Using the leftover cardboard from the box, cut two long strips and glue/tape them together. Don't make them too thick.



6

Measure the circumference of your child's head and turn the cardboard strip into a band that fits.



7

(OPTIONAL) Stick white paper over the cardboard.

8



Glue/tape the band inside the hat and add an optional chin strap.
